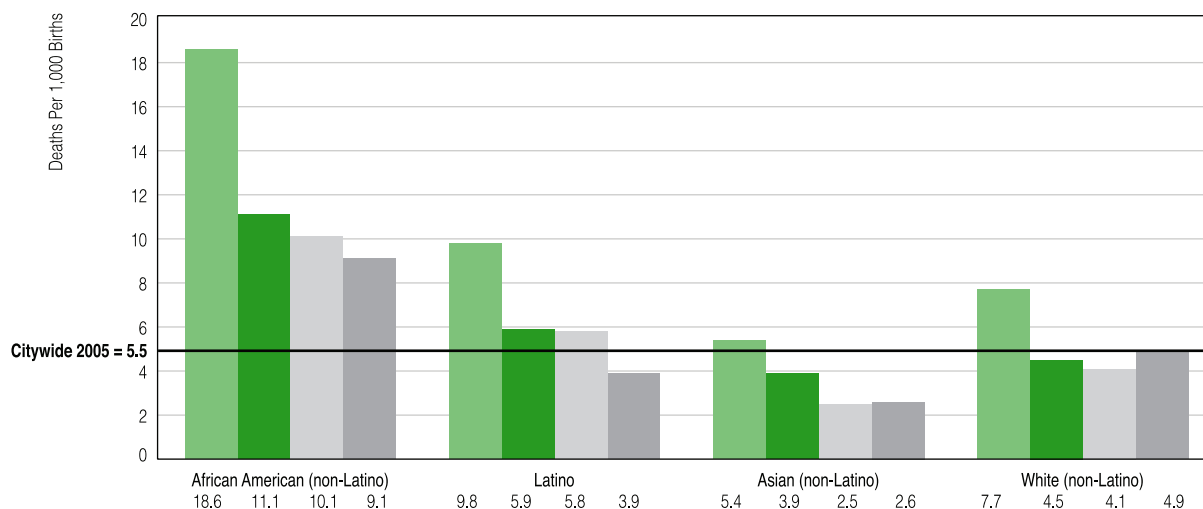


Infant Mortality by Race/Ethnicity: 1990-2005
