When you compare the populations served to the citywide population of children** you see that:

Black children are 25.8% of the City's population of children and, similarly, 25% of the recipients of the Children Under 5 Initiative are Black.

Latino children are 33.5% of the City's population of children and 49% of the recipients of the Children Under 5 Initiative are Latino.

Asian children are 10.9% of the City's population of children and 13% of the recipients of the Children Under 5 Initiative are Asian

White children are 26.8% of of the City's population of children and 13% of the recipients of the Children Under 5 Initiative are White

There are 8 Community Based Organizations that are funded through the City Council Children Under Five Mental Health Initiative: CERC (Early Childhood Center at Albert Einstein), Child Center of New York, JBFCS' "Relationships for Growth and Learning," OHEL's "The Children Under Five Program," Safe Horizon, Safe Space's "Seen and Heard," Staten Island Mental Health Society and University Settlement's "Butterflies Program."

To date, the programs serve 4,000 at-risk children and families across the City annually.

The providers offer services in 57 of the 59 CDs.

All CDs in the Bronx, Manhattan and Queens are served.

In Staten Island, all CDs with the exception of CD 3 are served. In Brooklyn, all CDS with exception of CD 11 are served.

The current supply of slots does not meet the overall demand and families are forced to do without critical mental health services. Neither Early Intervention programs nor outpatient mental health clinics provide these mental health services offered through the Children Under 5 Mental Health Initiative.

The attached chart illustrate the need for these services. There are 571,167 children under the age of 5 in NYC. Approximaely 47,407, or 8.3% have a behavrioral problem according to national prevalence estimates. The Children Under 5 initiative has the capacity to serve 4000 children a year and reaches them in 57 of the 59 Community Districts.
