Introduction, page 16: The second sentence in the Youth Employment section should be corrected to read:

“The percent of youth 16 to 19 years of age who were looking for work but could **not** find work, rose to 36% citywide in 2009, up from 22% in 2008 - now at the highest rate this decade.”

Correction is in bold.

Figure 30, page 56: Percentages in the pie were reversed in the print edition.

Keeping Track of Children in Queens

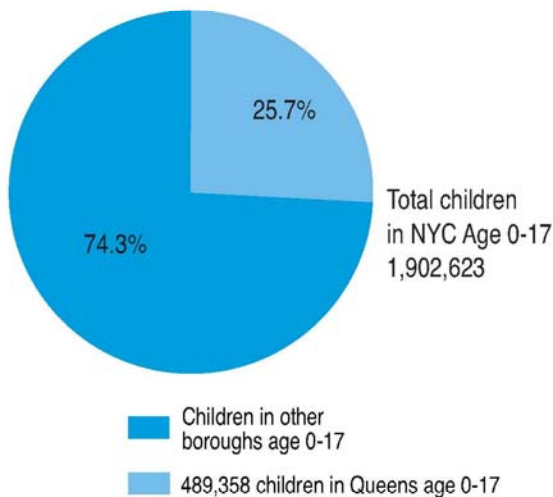
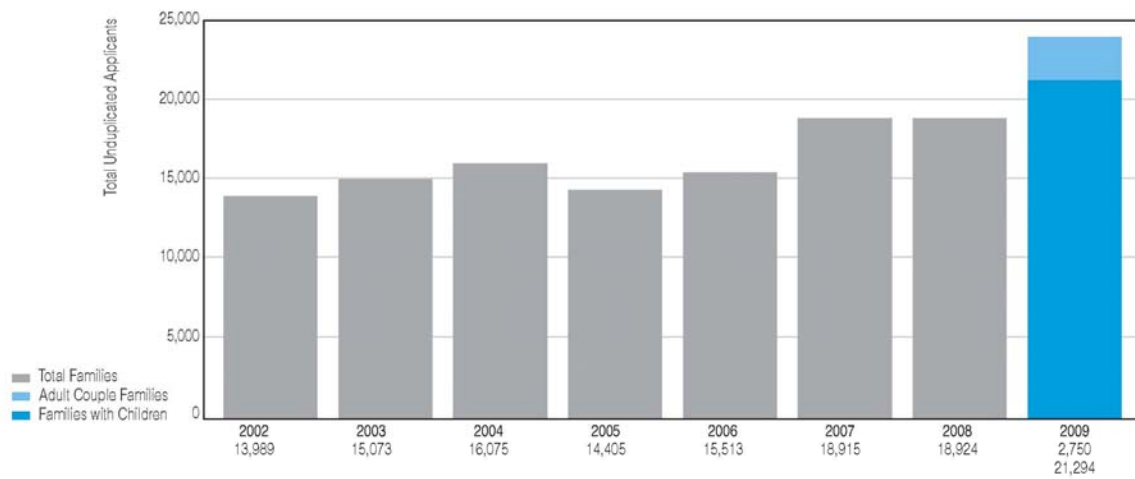


Figure 78, page 90: 2009 data incorrectly lists the unduplicated number of adult couple families applying to shelter as 8,625. The number of unduplicated adult couple families is actually 2,750.

The Number of Families Applying to City Shelters: FY 2002-2009

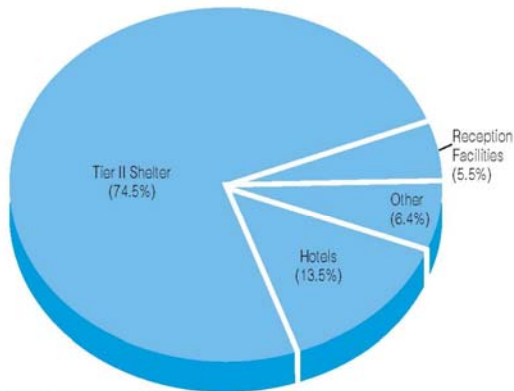

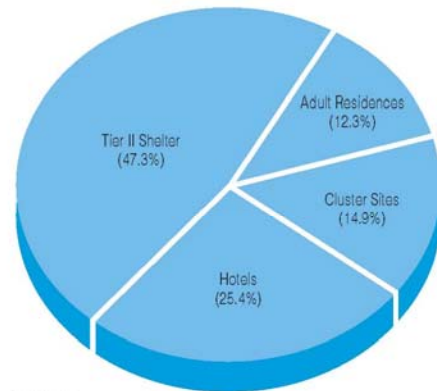
Figure 82, page 92: In the FY 2009 pie chart, a label and percentage for Scatter Sites was mistakenly included off to the side of the chart. The Department of Homeless Services no longer has Scatter Sites. The other percentages and labels in the figure are correct.

Average Number of Families = 4,828

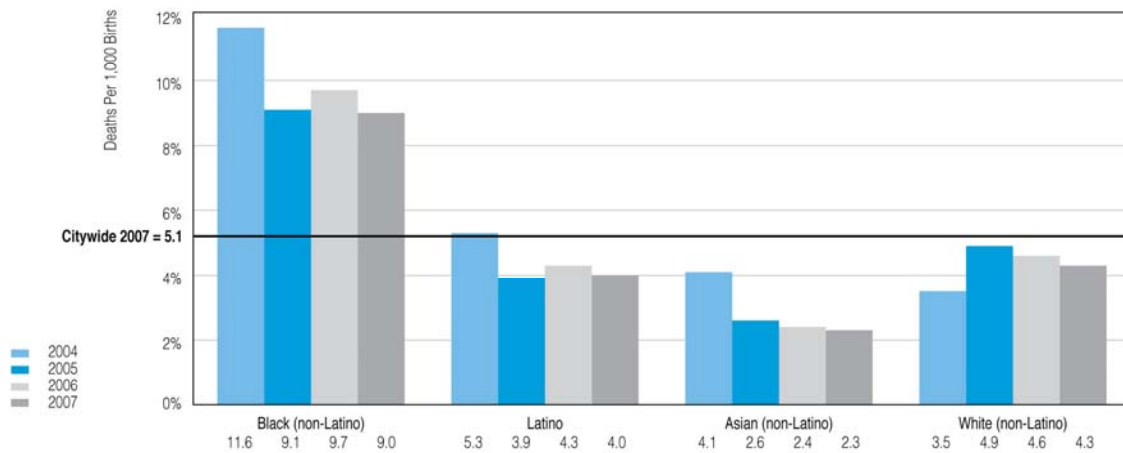


FY 2009
